



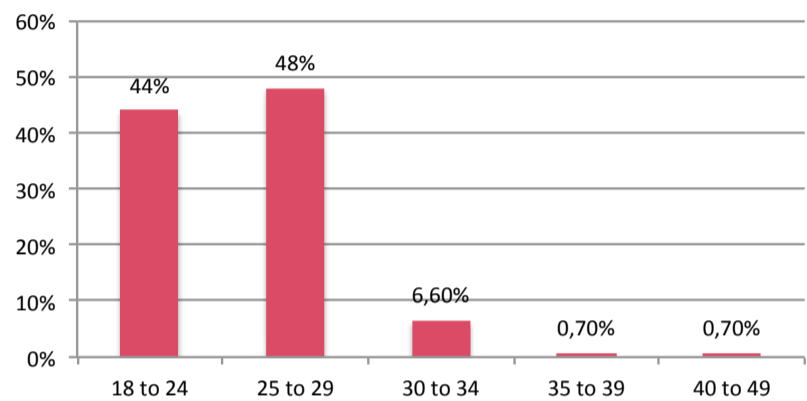

Thanks to 304 of you participating at our Diversity Study, we proudly present the results displaying the diversity of 44,2% of all scholarship holders.

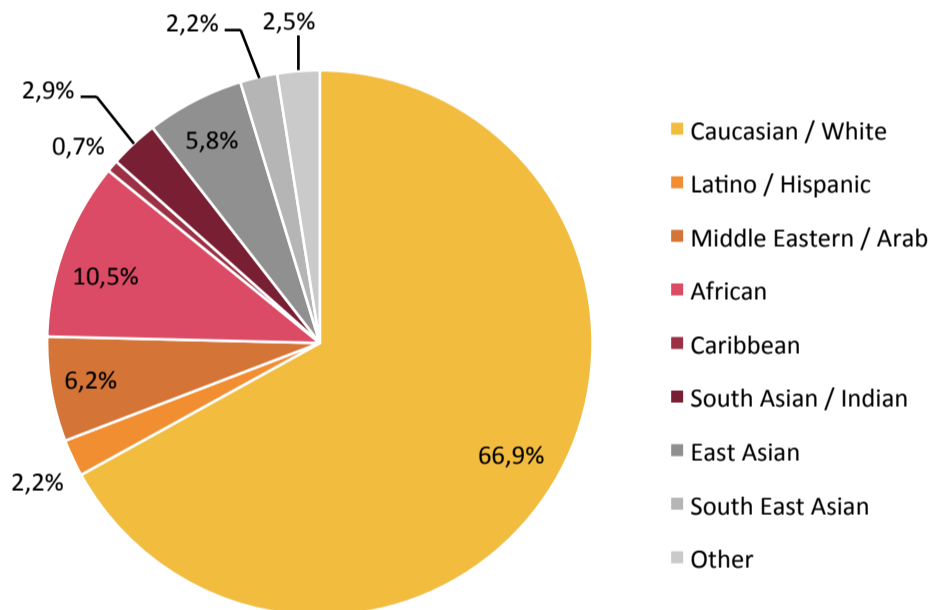

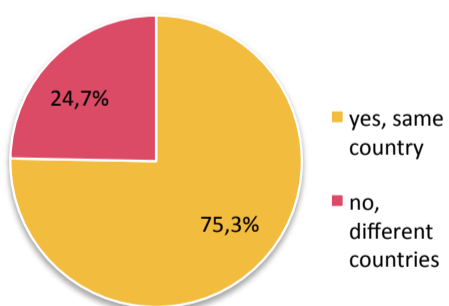

Self-identified ethnicity

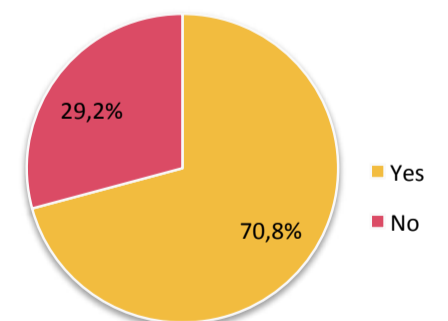
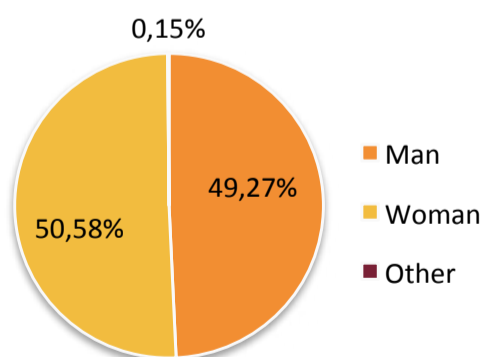


Is your citizenship from the country you feel most at home?

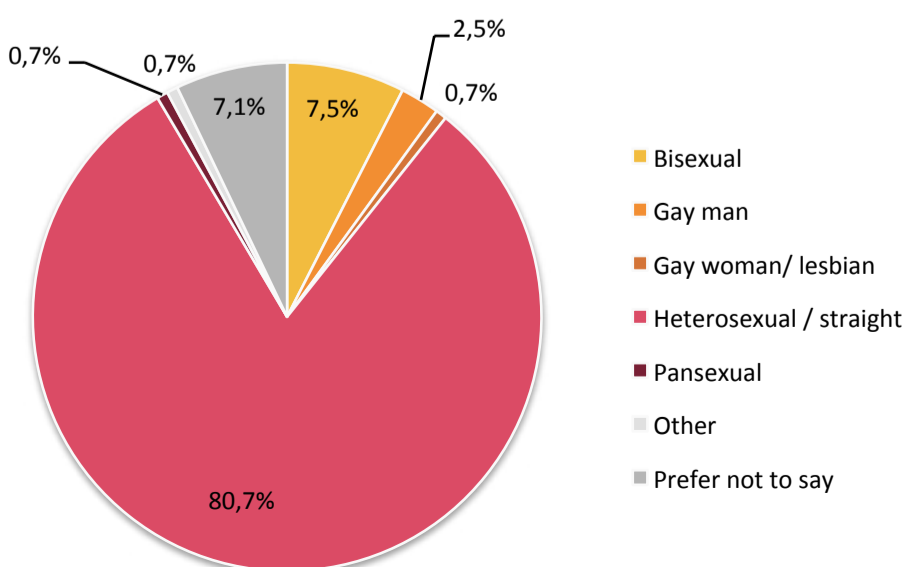


Is your native language the language you speak most often in your daily life?

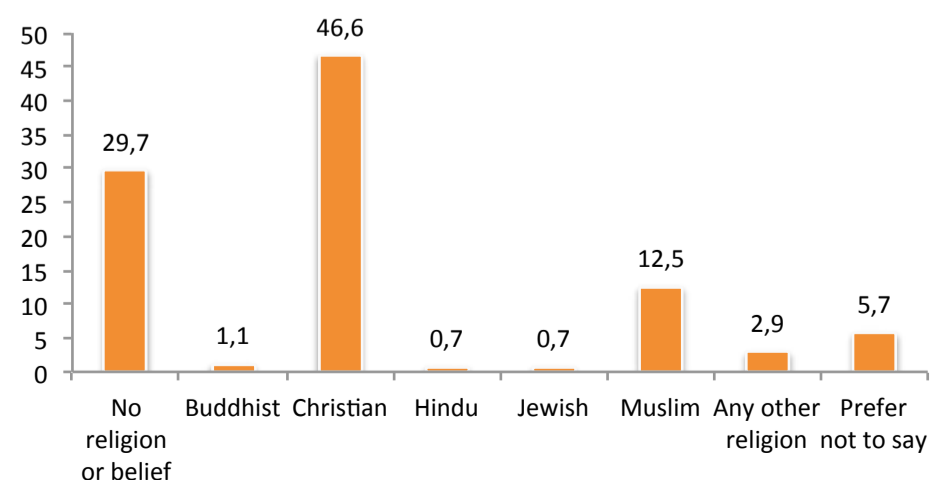
What is your gender?



What is your sexual orientation?

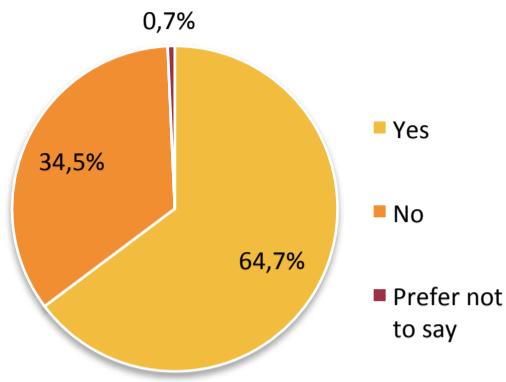


What is your religion or belief?

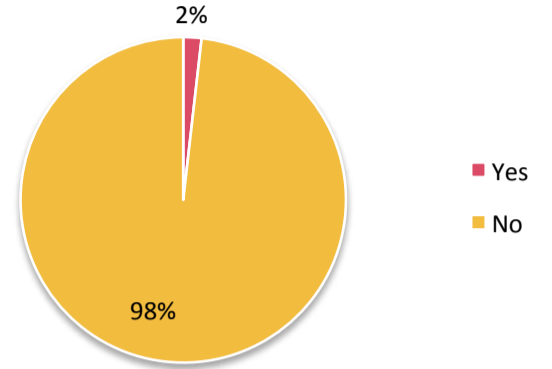




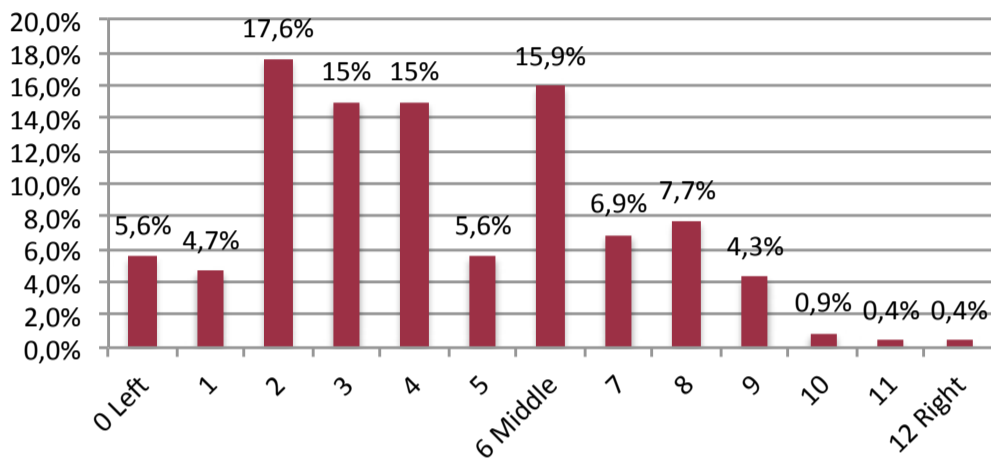
Did either one or both of your parents attend university?



Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition of the Equality Act?

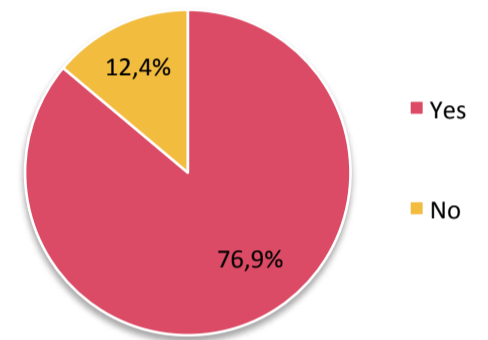


Thinking of your own political views, where would you place these on this scale?

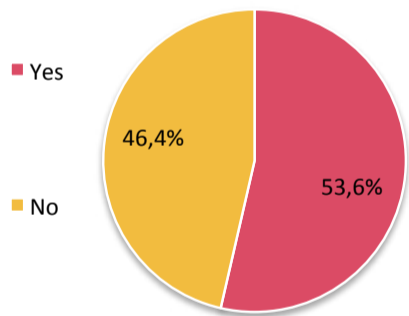
Have you ever voted in a political election?



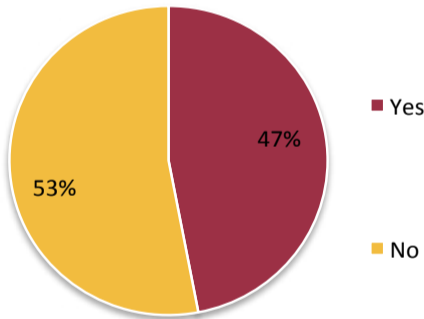

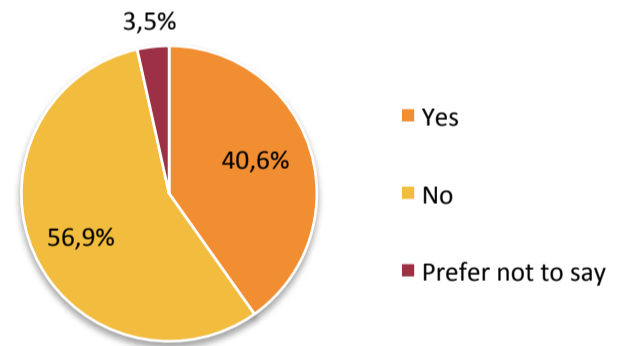
Have you ever used public transportation without paying?



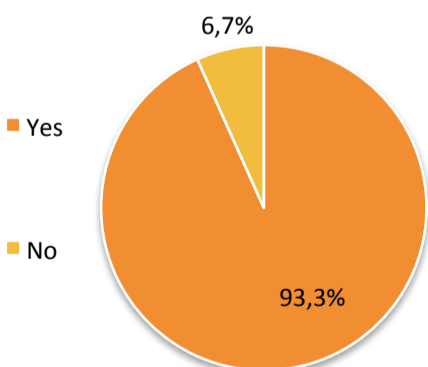
Have you ever done something minor illegal and got away with it?



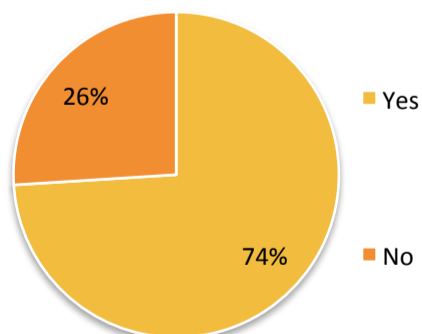
This year, are you receiving (significant) financial support from your parent(s) or other family members towards your education?



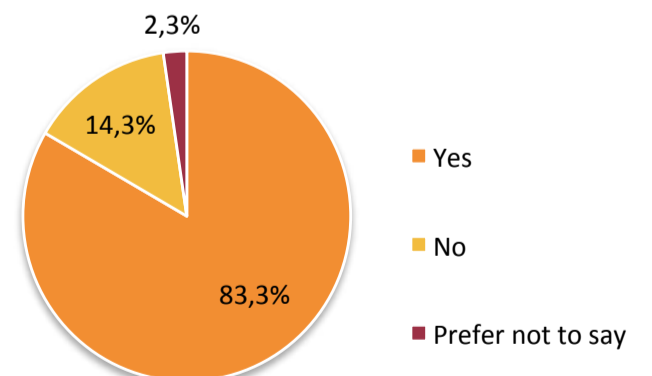
Do you know how to cook one of your countries typical dishes?



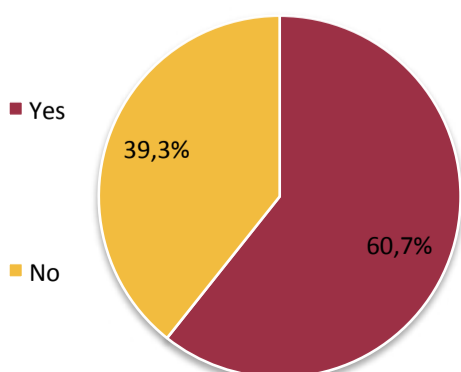
Can you sing your national anthem by heart?



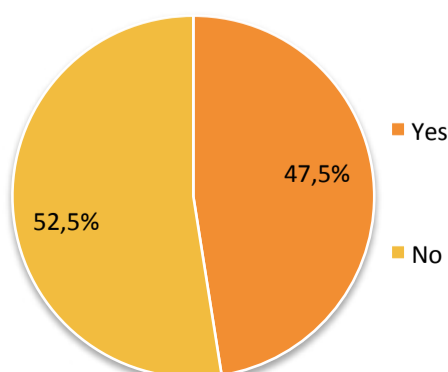
Would the household you're currently living in financially be able to replace a major electrical device like a washing machine, if it breaks?
